

He killed the ram and offered it to God as a sacrifice for himself and his family.






The other goat was slain and the high priest sprinkled its blood on the mercy seat in the Most Holy Place (which he entered only on the Day of Atonement) and on the alter.





**Problem:**  
The Hebrew  
writer says, “For  
it is not possible  
that the blood of  
bulls and of  
goats should  
take away sins.”  
(Heb. 10:4)





**So there *MUST* be a  
PERFECT SACRIFICE**



**25 nor was it that He would offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the holy place year by year with blood that is not his own.**

**26 Otherwise, He would have needed to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now once at the consummation of the ages He has been manifested to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.**

<sup>3</sup>Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."



## Jesus' answer

Matthew 4:4  
(NKJV)

<sup>4</sup>But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "



## Jesus' Temptation

Matthew 4:6 (NKJV)  
⁶and said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: ‘He shall give His angels charge over you,’ and, “In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.’ ”

Matthew 4:7  
(NKJV)

<sup>7</sup>Jesus said to him,  
“It is written  
again, ‘You shall  
not tempt the LORD  
your God.’ ”

Matthew 4:9  
(NKJV)

<sup>9</sup>And he said to Him, “All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me.”




## Jesus' answer

Matthew 4:10  
(NKJV)

<sup>10</sup>Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.' "

## Paul describes our new life as a new creation:

- “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”  
(2 Cor. 5:17).

**William Barclay says,**

- “Until we accept Jesus and take Him as our Savior and enthrone Him as our King we cannot be said to live at all. The man who lives a Christless life exists, but he does not know what life is. Jesus is the one person who can make life worth living and in whose company death is only the prelude to still fuller life.”

## Paul states:

- “For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.”  
(Rom. 8:18)

**K. H. Griffith Thomas said:**

- “Hope is an essential element of our salvation and must never be omitted from our contemplation of what the Christian life means.

## K. H. Griffith Thomas said:

- Faith looks backward and upward; hope looks onward.
- Faith accepts, but hope expects.
- Faith is concerned with Him who promises; but hope is occupied with the good things promised.
- Faith appropriates; but hope anticipates.”

## Paul looked back over his life and said:

- 2 Timothy 4:6-8 (NKJV)

- <sup>6</sup>For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand.
- <sup>7</sup>I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.
- <sup>8</sup>*Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.*
